

Music Director JUNICHI HIROKAMI

Born in Tokyo, Junichi Hirokami studied piano, composition and music under Atsutada Otaka before studying conducting at and graduating from Tokyo College of Music. At 26, he became the winner at the first Kondrashin International Conducting Competition in Amsterdam in 1984.

Since 1990, Hirokami has conducted the major orchestras around the world including the Orchestre National de France, Berlin Radio Symphony Orchestra, Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra, Orchestre Symphonique de Montreal, London Symphony Orchestra, Wiener Symphoniker, Vancouver Symphony Orchestra, L'Orchestra Sinfonica di Milano Giuseppe Verdi, Saint Petersburg Philharmonic Orchestra, Tchaikovsky Symphony Orchestra of Moscow, Baltimore Symphony Orchestra, Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra and Gewandhausorchester Leipzig.

Apart from guest appearances, he has served as Chief Conductor of Sweden's Norrköping Symphony Orchestra and the Limburg Symphony Orchestra, Principal Guest Conductor of the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic, Principal Conductor of Japan Philharmonic Orchestra and Music Director of the Columbus Symphony Orchestra.

In Japan, he has conducted all the major orchestras including the NHK Symphony Orchestra and Saito Kinen Orchestra. He received great acclaim for his appearance with the Mito Chamber Orchestra. He is prolific in opera, having led celebrated performances of *Un ballo in maschera* and *Rigoletto* at the Sydney Opera House. Other triumphs include *La Traviata* at the Fujiwara Opera, *Le Nozze di Figaro* and *Ainadamar* at the Nissay Theatre, and *La Traviata* and *Aida* at the New National Theatre Tokyo.

From 2008 to 2022, he created a golden era as Chief Conductor as well as Music and Artistic Advisor of the Kyoto Symphony Orchestra. In 2015, he received an award at the Suntory Music Award with the orchestra.

Currently, he serves as Artistic Leader of the Orchestra Ensemble Kanazawa, Friend of JPO / Artistic Advisor of the Japan Philharmonic Orchestra, and Friendship Conductor of the Sapporo Symphony Orchestra. The City of Kyoto Symphony Orchestra bestowed on him a special title after his name, 'Junichi Hirokami', in recognition of his years of service to the orchestra. He also serves as professor of conducting at Tokyo College of Music. Most recently, he became Music Director of the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra.

Resident Conductor GERARD SALONGA

Gerard Salonga has held the position of Resident Conductor of the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra (MPO) since 2019. He has served as Assistant Conductor of the Hong Kong Philharmonic (appointed by Jaap van Zweden) and Music Director of the ABS-CBN Philharmonic Orchestra in Manila. In 2021, he became Music Director of the Orchestra of the Filipino Youth (OFY).

He has worked as an assistant to conductors such as Jun Märkl, Hans Graf, Yu Long, Vladimir Ashkenazy, Mark Wigglesworth and Leonard Slatkin, and has conducted The Philippines, Thailand and South Denmark Philharmonics, Shanghai Opera House Orchestra and Chorus, Kunming Nie-Er Symphony, Evergreen Symphony of Taiwan, and the Bangkok, Singapore and Sydney Symphonies at iconic venues including London's Royal Albert Hall and Sydney Opera House.

Past collaborations have included with renowned artists such as Lea Salonga, Sumi Jo, Wang Leehom, Wu Tong, Tengku Irfan, Hacken Lee, Michael Ball, II Divo, Danielle de Niese, Ksenija Sidorova, Shen Yang, James Ehnes, Jan Lisiecki and The Beach Boys.

Gerard has conducted a wide range of concerts with the MPO including film, pops, symphony and family concerts. His arrangements have been performed by the BBC, Indianapolis and Guangzhou Symphony Orchestras, RTÉ Concert Orchestra, Cincinnati Pops and Royal Philharmonics, and he has conducted recordings of the Hong Kong Philharmonic for Sony Classical as well as the Sønderjyllands Symfoniorkester for Danacord.

In musical theatre, he has conducted *Carousel, They're Playing Our Song, Dreamgirls, Baby, West Side Story, Sweeney Todd* and *Little Women* in Manila and Singapore.

He has served on competition juries in Malaysia, The Philippines and Singapore, and given lectures on conducting at universities and higher learning institutions in Malaysia.

In 2012, Gerard was honoured as one of The Outstanding Young Men (TOYM), The Philippines' highest civilian award to achievers under 40. In 2021, he received the SUDI National Music Award by the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA).

MALAYSIAN PHILHARMONIC YOUTH ORCHESTRA



The initial steps towards realising the long-cherished dream of the late PETRONAS Chairman, Tun Azizan Zainul Abidin, to create a youth orchestra as a 'stage for young talents', alongside the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra (MPO), were taken on 13 January 2006. Some 500 aspiring musicians from across Malaysia auditioned and 110 — with an average age of 18 years — were selected to form the Malaysian Philharmonic Youth Orchestra (MPYO).


After a period of intensive training under mentors drawn from the ranks of the MPO, the MPYO gave its first public concert at Dewan Filharmonik PETRONAS on 25 August 2007. It has since established a pattern of music camps held three to four times a year, culminating in performances in Kuala Lumpur and beyond. It has since toured throughout Malaysia, and performed in Singapore, Brisbane, Hong Kong and Jakarta.


Auditions are held every year to provide opportunities for talented young Malaysian musicians to join the MPYO and participate in weekly orchestral training and performances, under the guidance of the MPO musicians as futors

The MPYO's music repertoire ranges from symphonic to specially-commissioned works by Malaysian composers. In 2010, an innovative project called 'Jazzaar' witnessed the MPYO collaborated with jazz musicians from the USA such as Fritz Renold and Randy Brecker. In 2015, the MPYO was given the honour to perform at the opening of the 128th International Olympic Committee (IOC) Session in Kuala Lumpur.

More than just a youth orchestra, the MPYO musicians are given consistent intensive trainings under the MPO's Talent Development programme through the transfer of knowledge, skills and expertise including discipline, teamwork and leadership in orchestral setting, participation in masterclasses and workshops with distinguished soloists, regular performances and collaborations with other youth orchestras. This is part of the MPO's initiative to nurture music appreciation among Malaysians.


