The Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra (MPO) gave its inaugural performance at Dewan Filharmonik PETRONAS (DFP) on 17 August 1998. With the initial search for outstanding musicians involving a worldwide audition tour, the MPO today is made up of many talented Malaysian musicians and musicians from other nations, a beautiful example of harmony among different cultures and nationalities.

With each new season, the MPO continues to present an exciting programme of orchestral music drawn from over three centuries, as well as the crowd-pleasing concert series. Its versatility transcends genres, from classical masterpieces to film music, pop. jazz, traditional, contemporary and commissioned works.

Among renowned Malaysian artists who have mesmerized audiences with the MPO include SM Salim, Sheila Majid, M.Nasir, Siti Nurhaliza, Jamal Abdillah, Ella, Dayang Nurfaizah, Aishah, Jaclyn Victor and Aubrey Suwito.

A host of internationally acclaimed musicians have performed with the MPO including Lorin Maazel, Sir Neville Marriner, Yehudi Menuhin, Joshua Bell, Harry Connick Jr., José Carreras, Andrea Bocelli, Dame Kiri Te Kanawa, Vladimir Ashkenazy, Chris Botti, Branford Marsalis and Judika, many of whom have praised the MPO for its fine musical qualities and vitality.

The MPO regularly performs in major cities of Malaysia such as in Alor Setar, George Town, Ipoh, Johor Bahru, Kuantan, Kota Kinabalu, Kuching and many more. Internationally, it has toured Singapore (1999, 2001, 2003, 2005 and 2018), Japan (2001, 2009 and 2017), Korea (2001), Australia (2004), China (2006 and 2019), Taiwan (2007) and Vietnam (2013). The MPO has also released 21 CDs.

The MPO remains steadfast in its mission to be the premier Malaysian orchestra, providing the ultimate music experience through the power of live music that educates, entertains and inspires. Its main benefactor is PETRONAS, and its patron is YABhg. Tun Dr. Siti Hasmah Haji Mohd Ali.

Gerard Salonga

Gerard Salonga has held the position of Resident Conductor of the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra (MPO) since 2019. He has served as Assistant Conductor of the Hong Kong Philharmonic (appointed by Jaap van Zweden) and Music Director of the ABS-CBN Philharmonic Orchestra in Manila. In 2021, he became Music Director of the Orchestra of the Filipino Youth (OFY).

He has worked as an assistant to conductors such as Jun Märkl, Hans Graf, Yu Long, Vladimir Ashkenazy, Mark Wigglesworth and Leonard Slatkin, and has conducted The Philippines, Thailand and South Denmark Philharmonics, Shanghai Opera House Orchestra and Chorus, Kunming Nie-Er Symphony, Evergreen Symphony of Taiwan, and the Bangkok, Singapore and Sydney Symphonies at iconic venues including London's Royal Albert Hall and Sydney Opera House.

Past collaborations have included with renowned artists such as Lea Salonga, Sumi Jo. Wang Leehom. Wu Tong, Tengku Irfan, Hacken Lee, Michael Ball, Il Divo, Danielle de Niese, Ksenija Sidorova, Shen Yang, James Ehnes, Jan Lisiecki and The Beach Boys.

Gerard has conducted a wide range of concerts with the MPO including film, pops, symphony and family concerts. His arrangements have been performed by the BBC, Indianapolis and Guangzhou Symphony Orchestras, RTÉ Concert Orchestra, Cincinnati Pops and Royal Philharmonics, and he has conducted recordings of the Hong Kong Philharmonic for Sony Classical as well as the Sønderjyllands Symfoniorkester for Danacord.

In musical theatre, he has conducted Carousel, They're Playing Our Song, Dreamgirls, Baby, West Side Story, Sweeney Todd and Little Women in Manila and Singapore.

He has served on competition juries in Malaysia, The Philippines and Singapore, and given lectures on conducting at universities and higher learning institutions in Malaysia.

In 2012, Gerard was honoured as one of The Outstanding Young Men (TOYM), The Philippines' highest civilian award to achievers under 40. In 2021, he received the SUDI National Music Award by the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA).



Nadia Aqilah Bajuri is a singer, performer and songwriter) born in 1985 in Selangor. Her early beginnings in the musical scene saw her as a member of female groups M'Braze and Luscious. Since then, she began to compose and write her own songs. She later ventured into acting and dancing, and was offered roles in various local musicals and television programmes. She launched her first solo album in 2010.

Among her achievements are nominations in Bangsawan Dendam Laksamana (2018), a film inspired by The Importance Of Being Ernest at Anugerah Pengkritik Filem (2018) and a telemovie at Anugerah Skrin (2016).

She won Best Performance in a Leading Role in The Last Five Years and Best Performance in a Supporting Role as 'Saloma' in P Ramlee The Musical, both at the BOH Cameronian Arts Awards (2015). In 2014, she was nominated for Best Actress in her film Zaiton Ceritaku at Malaysia Film Festival and Anugerah Skrin. Her other film credits include Legend of Pontianak and Mencari Rahmat.

Nadia is an active theatre actress with numerous stage performances to her credit, presented across Malaysia, at Singapore's The Esplanade and she participated in Malaysian Night at Davos, Switzerland in 2013.



Pat Ibrahim has a vast experience in performing arts for more than 35 years and is sought after by major event companies, houses. performing production academies and television. His expertise and dramatic flair with an original sense of musicality sets him apart from his peers.

Born and raised in Johor Bahru, Pat pursed his passion for the stage after being inspired by the movie Flashdance. His experience is wide-ranging and varied from performing, conceptualizing choreographing. and designing to directing and producing. He is also a renowned musical theatre director. creative director and a super imaginative show creator. Among the prominent stage performances that he was involved in include Puteri Gunung Ledang The Musical, Terima Kasih Cinta, P Ramlee The Musical, Dari Penang Ke Singapura, Muzikal Wajah Rahsia Hati, CIMB Artober Art & Soul, 27th ASEAN Summit Gala Dinner, MUD: Our Story of Kuala Lumpur, Konsert Nurkasih Dato Siti Nurhaliza, 8TV Shout Awards and Didi & Friends Bersama MPO: Mana Binggo?



Professional writer of art & literature since 1996. Among the first graduates of Masters In Creative of Arts at ASWARA. Writes in various mediums such as novels, short stories, TV dramas, plays, documentaries and films. Authored more than 100 telemovie scripts and drama series for TV stations.

Honoured with the award for Sembilan's Young Esteemed Writers in Literature & Intellect in 2004. Honoured with award for National Arts Award, 2009 . Recipient of the MASTERA Award in 2008 by the Southeast Asian Literature Council for Malaysian writers in the playwright category. Has also received 'The Natural Author' award in conjunction with International Woman's Day 2022. Served as scriptwriting instructor at Revolution stage from 2018 to 2020. Actively continues writing and is presently a part-time lecturer under the Faculty of Creative Writing & Film at Aswara.

Among her awards include third place in tv writing - Finas 2000 (telemovie Teh, Limau Ais & Horoskop), second place film script -Finas 2001 (film Kiambang Menadah Bulan). Best TV Drama Script - Anugerah Seri Angkasa 2010 (telemovie Perempuan) and Best Script - Anugerah Skrin 2016 (telemovie Rekah).



Precision Movement Dance Group

Aspired to be the best dance group in Malaysia, the group put together a troupe of carefully chosen, experienced and dedicated performers committed to give their best performance at each show they undertake. Among its achievements are being the champion for Eco World dance/musical competition from 2016 to 2019, runner-ups for SP Setia dance/musical competition in 2023 and represented Malaysia at the 4th Annual Hawaii Dance Festival in 2002. The group has choreographed for many prominent local artists such as Dato Sri Siti Nurhaliza, Anuar Zain, Stacy and Vince Chong and has produced musicals and choreographed a wide range of genres for public events, television, video clips, award shows and corporate events.

Pewaris Seni Anak Tari

Sekolah Seni Malaysia Kuala Lumpur (SSeMKL) is a full boarding art school under the Ministry of Education Malaysia. In its dance department, the heirs of the art known as 'Anak Tari' are a group of selected students who represent the school in various performances, competitions, and cultural programs at school, state, national and international levels. They are trained by qualified instructors to ensure that traditional. contemporary and modern dance learned, preserved and performed at the highest standard.

Its establishment is in line with the school's mission to nurture a young generation who are disciplined, knowledgeable and talented in the dance field, uphold and preserve the nation's cultural heritage through the appreciation and practice of Malay and diverse ethnic dances of Malaysia, provide exposure and performance opportunities for students as preparation for higher education in the arts and position SSeMKL as a centre of excellence in dance education.

Through this platform, the group serves not only as the school's official dance troupe but also as cultural ambassadors, embodying the role of young successors in continuing Malaysia's rich dance heritage.

PROGRAMME NOTES

One of the MPO's main objectives is to nurture the appreciation of classical music among the young generation. One of the mechanics is to provide a platform for them to experience live classical music with content tailored to their interest and age.

The Family Fun Day series was borne from this aim and every year, the series deliver exciting, family-friendly concerts with content specially curated for children and young audience. And today's concert continues this mission of early education and exposure in musical appreciation. On top of being educational, the concert is also an example of the powerful impact of public contribution and the unwavering support of the community. Such contribution made the MPO's educational efforts possible, making classical music more accessible, to entertain, to nurture and to teach.

Conducted by Gerard Salonga with actress Nadia Agilah as narrator, this concert tells the folktale of Puteri Gunung Ledang in seven parts, each accompanied by different music compositions. Joined by two local dance troupes, it weaves together Western masterpieces and local songs. Through this synergy, the MPO elevates local music for the younger audience through fresh arrangements.

The 60-minute performance presents a programme which include MAHLER's Symphony No. 1 (first movement), a composition often dubbed "Titan". With a beginning that feels like the first light of dawn, young listeners can imagine nature's awakening and how silence builds into small sounds and texture.

Based on the story 1001 Nights, RIMSKY-KORSAKOV's Scheherazade is a composition filled with exotic colours, shown through sweeping violin solos and shimmering strings that depict Scheherazade's tales. Dramatic and vivid, it shows younger audience that a story can be told in orchestral music.

Arranged by CHUA, the medley of Malaysian folk songs of Chan Mali Chan, Jong Jong Inai and Rasa Sayang brings the audience closer to home. Joyous, melodic and rhythmic, these familiar local folksongs are known for generations. They are filled with communal feelings which shows how music lives through people's memories.

GRIEG's Morning Mood: From the Peer Gynt Suite is a familiar song that reflects the day's gentle awakening with bird sounds in the background of light, pastoral calm. The song is used in Peer Gynt, the play by Henrik Ibsen, when Peer Gynt is stranded in the Moroccan desert after his companions took his yacht and abandoned him there.

An expression of sorrow, loss and devotion, PROKOFIEV's Romeo & Juliet: Romeo at Juliet's Grave shows how melody and orchestration can deliver a deeply emotional and tragic scene.

MUSSORGSKY's Night on Bald Mountain is one thrilling and loud music, stormy and an almost supernatural piece. It is a song that blends music, drama and action.



In Nocturnes: Nuages, DEBUSSY presents contemplative impression and subtle nuance with melodious music. The composer once said that he associates "nuages" (clouds) with the experience of their effect on the River Seine in Paris.

Composed by MERICAN and arranged by CHUA, Tanah Pusaka is a classic and powerful patriotic song about one's complete devotion for one's homeland. Written in 1960, the song, according to ASWARA (Akademi Seni Budaya & Warisan) lecturer Dr James Boyle, is a "perfectly structured popular ballad form of songwriting" that "elevates the performer and listener to levels of great pride."

STRAVINSKY's Firebird Finale is triumphant and glowing, a powerful rousing end that will leave audience uplifted.

For young listeners, this concert is an immersive musical experience; the violins' crescendo, the full sweep of an orchestra and seeing their culture in songs is inspirational and educational. Nonetheless, such diverse and exciting presentation would not have been possible without continuous support towards the MPO. Through the generosity of the public, the MPO will continue educating the younger generation about music, its beauty and the positive effects it brings.



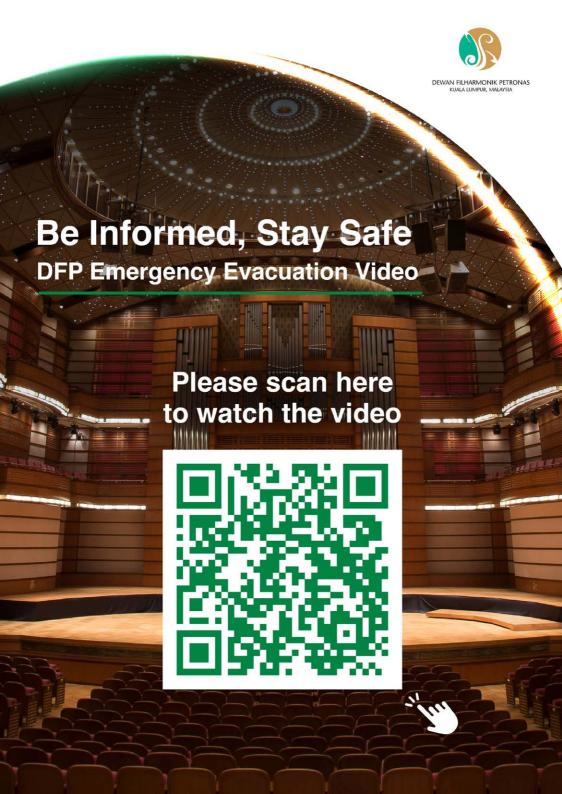
